Glacier



A huge mass of ice that formed from accumulated and compacted snow that slowly moves down a slope

Coastline




The outline or shape of a coast or the boundary between land and a lake or ocean

Sand Dune



Hills formed by the wind blowing sand

Mountain



A large, natural rise in elevation that has steep sides and is taller than a hill

River



A natural flow of water that follows a path into another body of water

Delta



A triangle-shaped (deposit) landform at the mouth of a river as it empties into another body of water

Lake



A large body of water with land all around it
