IB Learner Profile Trait Poster

As an IB MYP student, you have been learning about the ten learner profile traits. These include: Inquirer, Knowledgeable, Thinker, Communicator, Principled, Open-minded, Caring, Risk-taker, Balanced, and Reflective. Now you will have the opportunity to analyze one of these traits in two characters of your choice and examine how these traits will help you become a better scholar this year.

Choose <u>one</u> learner profile trait from the list above. Then **create a poster** explaining your IB learner profile trait through the use of an **example** and a **non-example**. Your example and your non-example may be **fictional characters** from a novel, movie, or television program. Be sure to explain how each character exemplifies or does not exemplify this trait. Use **examples** (supporting details) to support your points.

Then, choose <u>two</u> IB learner profile traits that you would like to develop this school year. Provide a reason for choosing each profile trait and specific examples of how will you use each profile trait to help you become a better scholar.

Your poster must include:

- your IB learner profile traits
- the names of your example and non-example characters
- an image or drawing of both your example and non-example characters
- one paragraph (6-8 sentences) explaining why your chosen character **exemplifies** your IB learner profile trait
- one paragraph (6-8 sentences) explaining why your chosen non-example character shows the **opposite** of your IB learner profile trait.
- one paragraph (6-8 sentences) explaining the two profile traits you will develop this school year and how you will improve them.

Be sure to:

- **give specific details and examples** about why or how each character exemplifies or is the antithesis of your learner profile traits
- use correct spelling, grammar, and punctuation
